
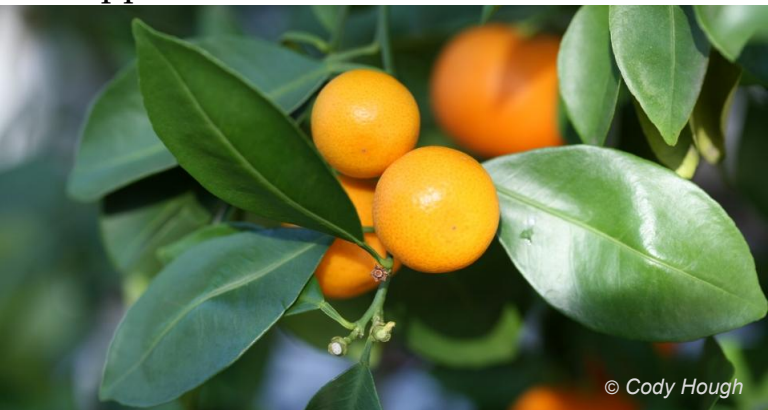


Calamondin



Scientific Name: *Citrofortunella microcarpa*

Origin: Exotic, Native to China or Philippines

This citrus tree bears fruit year-round and can be grown in a container! The orange fruit is fairly small. Its juice is quite acidic and can be used to season food. The flowers and leaves are fragrant. The tree's branches may have a few short spines. This citrus can be grown as a tree, hedge or houseplant. Tolerates part shade, but best flowering occurs in full sun. Best with consistent and regular watering. Established trees have moderate drought tolerance. Avoid wet poorly drained soils.
