



This showy evergreen tree produces an abundance of large double flowers, 3-5 inches in diameter, fragrant. Most gardenias are fairly adaptable shrubs tolerant of sun or semi-shade, and do best in a well-drained, humus-rich, acidic soil. Place in light to moderate shade, preferably with minimum competition from tree roots. Add plenty of organic matter, such as compost or ground bark to as large an area as possible. Water gardenias regularly. Grown indoors, these plants need bright light and moderate temperatures.
