



Scientific Name: Ficus carica

Origin: Exotic, northern Africa, southern Europe, western Asia & northern Pakistan.



This fig tree is known for its spreading habit, attractive foliage and edible fruit. It tolerates heat and sun, and can be maintained smaller by pruning annually after fruit harvest. The tree's milky sap can irritate hands if not washed promptly; wear gloves when pruning tree or picking fruit. Figs are best grown in organically rich, moist, well-drained soils in full sun to part shade. Water regularly during the growing season but reduce watering in fall. info@smarttreespacific.org
