




<u>Scientific Name:</u> *Hibiscus arnottianus* <u>Origin:</u> Endemic to Hawai'i, meaning only



This endemic Hawaiian hibiscus is native to the moist to wet forests of the mountains of Moloka'i and O'ahu. The large, brilliant flowers last for one day and have a slight fragrance. The plant can take a variety of forms and may be pruned to a desirable shape, but will grow large naturally. Recommended to grow in full sun in a fertile, well-draining soil that is slightly acidic.
