

Scientific Name: Hibiscus brackenridgei Origin: Endemic to Hawai'i, meaning only found here.



The bright yellow flowers are the true Hawai'i state flower! This plant may grow quickly and be prone to breaking or tipping over, rerooting where it touches the soil. To prevent this, the plant can be pruned heavily after the flowering season (winter-spring). It does very well in sunny areas such as south and west facing areas. Over watering can cause mildew on leaves and root rot.
