

Meyer Lemon



Scientific Name: *Citrus x meyeri*

Origin: Exotic, Native to China

This popular hybrid lemon tree bears large, juicy fruit sweeter than typical lemons, has a thinner skin and is borne throughout the year. This citrus tree is slightly thorny. It can be pruned to a small size and can provide light shade in a small yard. Plant in an area with well-drained soil that receives at least six hours of sunlight. Wait a year before fertilizing to allow for sufficient root growth. Newly planted citrus trees can take two to four years before producing fruit. As the tree matures, the amount of lemons will increase.
