

Tiare



Scientific Name: *Gardenia taitensis*

Origin: Exotic, Native to Melanesia and Western Polynesia

This multi-stemmed shrub can be trained to grow upright. This showy tree has glossy, green leaves and abundant white pinwheel-shaped blossoms that have a light and spicy scent. The plant should receive at least five hours of sunlight each day for best results, though if growing the plant outdoors, partial shade is recommended. Moderate frequent watering is required. If planted in a container, make sure the soil doesn't dry out. Indoor gardenias require higher Humidity. Gardenias require heavy fertilizing.
