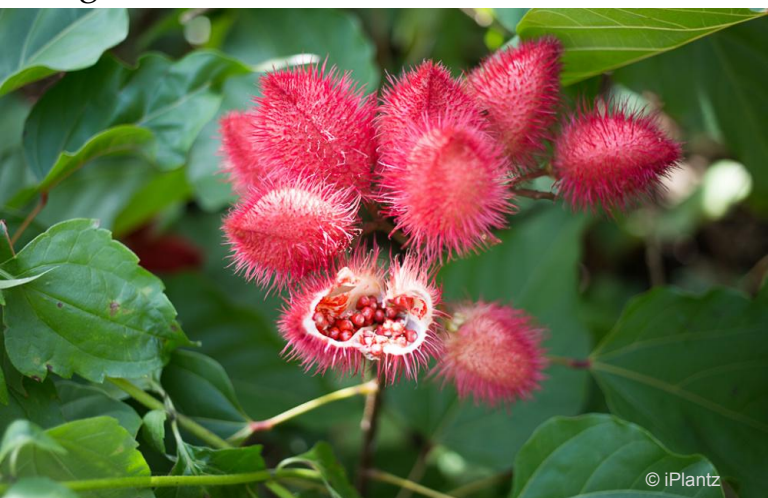


Lipstick Tree




Scientific Name: *Bixa orellana*

Origin: Native to Americas, aka annatto

Grown as a shrub or a small tree. It bears clusters of white or pink flowers, resembling single wild roses, that appear at the tips of the branches. In its native range, the seeds were originally used to make red body paint and lipstick - which is why it is called the lipstick tree. It prefers year-round moisture, good drainage, and moderately fertile soil in full sun or partial shade.
