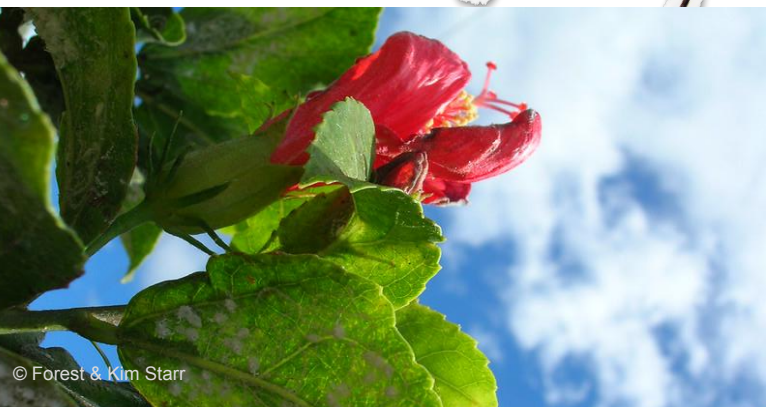


# Koki'o 'ula'ula

Scientific Name: *Hibiscus koki'o*

Origin: Endemic to Hawaiian Islands

This Hawaiian hibiscus has beautiful flowers that will bloom year round. The solitary and striking flowers develop near the end of the branches. The tolerance of Koki'o to dry conditions means that it is a good native species for planting in dry, leeward regions of the Hawaiian Islands that do not require extensive additional watering. These are small trees and do well as container plants in 3 gallon or larger pots in sunny locations.
